

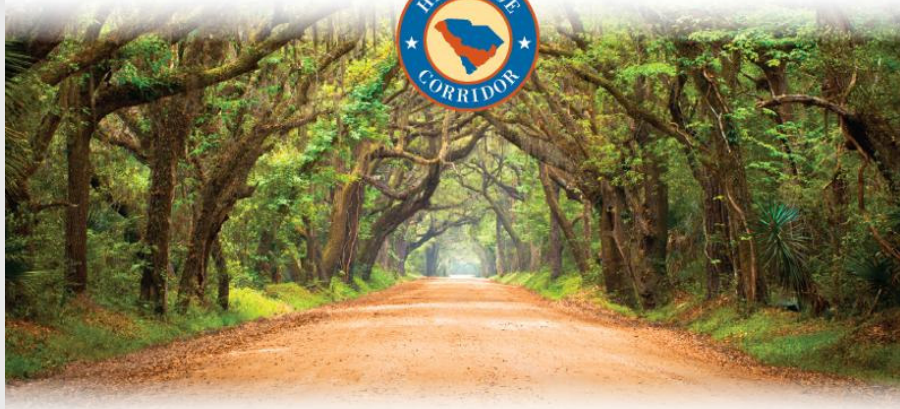

Rosemary Inn & Lookaway Inn

Don't worry, you are not seeing double. These two sister properties are a stones throw away from each other in North Augusta, SC and are the essence of what southern hospitality means. Built by two brothers during the turn of the century, both Rosemary and Lookaway are now boutique inns that are listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Guests can take in the grand columns, wrap around porches, 100 year-old magnolias and a classic southern breakfast all located conveniently on the banks of the Savannah River.

Maybe some rafting at [Wildwater](#) in the Upstate, fishing and kayaking at our [State Parks](#), find a vaca spot that matches your personality at one of the [Charleston area beaches](#), shop and stroll at the Harborwalk in historic [Georgetown](#), and load the kids up for a [Pirate Adventure](#) before you check out the Marshwalk at [Murrells Inlet](#), the Seafood Capital of SC.



Summer just isn't the same without farms, road-side stands and quick stops to make your summertime menu fresh! To name just a few, we recommend **Happy Berry** (photo above by Megan Greer) for some sweet fruity treats and then **Split Creek** goat dairy for some feta w/ sun dried tomatoes, fudge and drinkable yogurt!

We also can't stop thinking about the hot dogs and homemade soft-serve ice cream from **Healing Springs Country Store** in Blackville, the bread and pies from **Miller's**, and the fresh doughnuts from **White Pond. Cook's** is also a must-stop for a road-side snack.

Near the coast we've scoped out some of the best places to stop to grab an ice cold beverage and something to grill. **Legare Farms** for their meat, veggies and salsas, **Charleston Tea Plantation** and **Irvin House Vineyards/Firefly Distillery** for your beverage of choice, **Boone Hall Farm Market** for either their meatloaf or fresh seafood and drool-worthy side dishes ready to eat.
